Dear Parents and Carers,

A confirmed/positive case of Covid-19 has been identified in our Nursery.

This means we have to close the Nursery for all children and staff.  
Nursery will reopen on Monday 28 September for all children and staff.

Nursery staff will be providing online learning using Class Dojo and will also keep in contact with Nursery parents and families by email and 'phone during this time.

It is important for the Nursery children to isolate at home and not play out with other children for these 14 days. Please do not visit other households either.


If you are a family with brothers and sisters in Reception, Year 1 and/or Year 2 they can continue to attend school as usual, unless the Nursery child shows symptoms of Covid-19 which are:

- High Temperature – hot to touch on your chest or back
- New continuous cough – this means coughing a lot over 1 hour or 3 or 4 coughing episodes over 24 hours
- Loss or change to your sense of taste and smell – this means you've notice you cannot smell or taste anything or things smell or taste differently to normal

The Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 year groups will be open as normal.
