Dear Parents and Carers,

A confirmed/positive case of Covid-19 has been identified in our Year 1 year group.

This means we have to close the Year 1 Year Group for all children and staff for 14 days.

Year 1 will reopen on Wednesday 4 November for all children and staff.

There are some links on Class Dojo, look for the Oxford Owl and White Rose links for holiday learning. As it is half term the teachers will not be sending work for your child.

It is important for the Year 1 children to isolate at home and not play out with other children for these 14 days. Please do not visit other households either.

If you are a family with brothers and sisters in Nursery, Reception or Year 2 they can continue attend school as usual, on Monday 2 November, unless the Year 1 child shows symptoms of Covid-19 which are:

- High Temperature – hot to touch on your chest or back
- New continuous cough – this means coughing a lot over 1 hour or 3 or 4 coughing episodes over 24 hours
- Loss or change to your sense of taste and smell – this means you've notice you cannot smell or taste anything or things smell or taste differently to normal.

The Nursery, Reception and Year 2 Year groups will be open as normal after the holiday on Monday 2 November, but will need to be collected at 1pm.
